RES 2017-1046 Contract with Animal Birth Control Clinic for Low Cost Spay and Neuter Services

Carrie Kuehl, Executive Director, Animal Birth Control Clinic, explained that Waco residents can provide their water bill as proof of residency to qualify for low cost spay and neuter services. When necessary another utility bill or copy of their lease may also be used as proof of residency. Animal Care officers will also provide vouchers to encourage compliance of the Animals Ordinance. Wiley Stem, Deputy City Manager explained the success of the program in reducing the intake at the animal shelter.
